THE SUMMER RESORTS (DEVELOPMENT) LAWS, 1938 AND 1946.

SANCTION OF ACQUISITION OF LAND UNDER SECTION 29.

WINSTER,
Governor.

Whereas the Summer Resort Development Board for Platres have, by a resolution of the appropriate majority, under section 27 of the Summer Resorts (Development) Laws, 1938 and 1946, decided that the land described in the Schedule hereto should be acquired for the purpose of establishing therein or thereon a place for the parking of carriages, motor cars and other vehicles, a lair and petroleum stores ;

And whereas the provisions of sections 27 and 28 of the aforementioned Laws have been complied with ;

Now therefore I, the Governor, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 29 of the Summer Resorts (Development) Laws, 1938 and 1946, do hereby sanction the acquisition of the land described in the Schedule hereto for the purposes hereinbefore set out.

SCHEDULE.

The land of an extent of three cvleks and 1,800 square feet, under plot 483/2 of Plan 47/11, bounded by : school yard, carriage road, Hariklou Haralambi, water channel and Ioannis K. Monoyios of Kato Platres situated within the limits of the Summer Resort of Pano Platres and registered in the name of Despina Ioanni K. Monoyiou of Kato Platres under registration No. 2141 of the 22nd August, 1946.
