THE POST OFFICE LAWS, 1881 TO 1933.

ORDER IN COUNCIL No. 2242

MADE UNDER SECTION 6.

WINSTER,
Governor.

I, the Governor in Council, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 6 of the Post Office Laws, 1881 to 1933, do hereby order as follows:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Parcels Post (Rates of Postage) (Amendment No. 4) Order, 1947, and shall be read as one with the Parcels Post (Rates of Postage) Orders, 1946 to (No. 3) 1947 (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Order"), and the principal Order and this Order may together be cited as the Parcels Post (Rates of Postage) Orders, 1946 to (No. 4) 1947.

2. The Schedule to the principal Order is hereby amended by the deletion therefrom of the entries relating to Greece and Morocco—4. French Offices—and by the substitution therefor of the entries set out in the Schedule hereto.
