No. 247. THE CUSTOMS LAWS, 1936 TO 1946.

ORDER IN COUNCIL No. 2256

MADE UNDER SECTION 6.

In exercise of the powers vested in the Governor by section 6 of the Customs Laws, 1936 to 1946, I, the Acting Governor, with the advice of the Executive Council, do hereby order as follows:-

1. This Order may be cited as the Customs Houses (Days and Hours of Business) (Amendment) Order, 1947, and shall be read as one with the Customs Houses (Days and Hours of Business) Orders, 1943 to 1946, Gazettes: (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Order"), and the principal Supplement Order and this Order may together be cited as the Customs Houses 14.10.1943 (Days and Hours of Business) Orders, 1943 to 1947.

2. The principal Order is hereby amended by the deletion therefrom 11. 4.1946

of clause 3 and the substitution therefor of the following clause:-

"3. All Customs Houses shall be closed for business on Sundays, Saturdays after noon, New Year's Day, Good Friday, Saturday before Easter, Easter Monday, Empire Day, His Majesty's Birthday, Christmas Day and Boxing Day.
