### SUBSIDIARY LEGISLATION.

No. 263.

THE ELEMENTARY EDUCATION LAWS, 1933 TO 1947.

ORDER UNDER SECTION 6 (2).

WINSTER,

*Governor.*

In exercise of the powers vested in me by section 6 (2) of the Elementary Education Laws, 1933 to 1947, I, the Governor, do hereby order as follows :—

1. This Order may be cited as the Elementary Education (Prescription of Groups) Order, 1947.

2. In respect of each one of the religious communities shown in column 1 of the First Schedule hereto, the corresponding villages mentioned in column 2 of such Schedule shall be united into a group with the corresponding towns mentioned in column 3 of such Schedule, for all the purposes of the Elementary Education Laws, 1933 to 1947, except those of section 65 thereof.

3. In respect of each one of the religious communities shown in column 1 of the Second Schedule hereto, the several corresponding villages mentioned in column 2 of such Schedule shall be united in each case into a group for all the purposes of the Elementary Education Laws, 1933 to 1947.

4. The Elementary Education (Prescription of Schools) Orders, 1944 to 1947, are hereby repealed.

**THE LOAN (DEVELOPMENT AND WELFARE) LAW, 1947.**

**REGULATIONS MADE UNDER SECTION 11.**

WINSTER,  
*Governor.*

I, the Governor in Council, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 11 of the Loan (Development and Welfare) Law, 1947, do hereby make the following regulations.

1. These regulations may be cited as the Loan (Development and Welfare) Regulations, 1947.
2. In these regulations, unless the context otherwise requires—  
 “approved” means approved by the Treasurer;
