No. 273. THE POST OFFICE LAWS, 1881 TO 1933.

ORDER IN COUNCIL No. 2260

MADE UNDER SECTION 6.

WINSTER,
Governor.

In exercise of the powers vested in me by section 6 of the Post Office Laws, 1881 to 1933, I, the Governor, with the advice of the Executive Council, do hereby order as follows:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Parcels Post (Rates of Postage) (Amendment No. 5) Order, 1947, and shall be read as one with the Parcels Post (Rates of Postage) Orders, 1946 to (No. 4) 1947 (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Order") and the principal Order and this Order may together be cited as the Parcels Post (Rates of Postage) Orders, 1946 to (No. 5) 1947.

2. The Schedule to the principal Order is hereby amended as follows:—

(a) by the addition thereto in their alphabetical order of the new entries set out in the First Schedule hereto:

(b) by the deletion therefrom of the entries relating to the countries shown in the Second Schedule hereto and the substitution therefor of the entries relating to the same countries set out in the Second Schedule hereto.

No. 275. THE LAND ACQUISITION LAWS, 1899 TO 1947.

NOTIFICATION UNDER SECTIONS 2, 3 AND 4.

WINSTER,

Governor.

Whereas it has been represented to me that certain lands on which the Military Authorities constructed a military road in the village of Pyla, Larnaca District, are needed, and should be acquired, for use as a permanent public road.

Now, therefore, I, Reginald Thomas Herbert, Baron Winster of Witherslack, Privy Counsellor, Governor and Commander-in-Chief in and over the Colony of Cyprus, by virtue of the powers vested in me by Sections 2, 3 and 4 of the Land Acquisition Laws, 1899 to 1947, do
