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**No. 281. THE LAND ACQUISITION LAWS, 1899 TO 1947.**

NOTIFICATION UNDER SECTION 6.

In exercise of the powers vested in the Governor by section 6 of the Land Acquisition Laws, 1899 to 1947, and with reference to the Notification dated the 26th day of April, 1947, and published under No. 121 in Supplement No. 3 to the *Gazette* of the 1st day of May, 1947, relating to the establishment of a Leave Camp for service personnel in the district of Famagusta the cost whereof is to be borne by His Majesty's Military Authorities, His Excellency the Governor has been pleased to sanction and hereby sanctions the acquisition, under the provisions of the aforesaid Laws, of the immovable properties situated in Ayios Memnon Quarter of Famagusta town, particulars whereof are specifically set out in the notice of the Commissioner, Famagusta, published under Notification No. 162 in Supplement No. 3 to the *Gazette* of the 29th day of May, 1947, to vest and be registered in the name of His Majesty's Military Authorities SUBJECT only to a full right of way by any means whatsoever and for all purposes, being reserved for the public and recorded in the books of the Land Registry Office through Plot No. 152 (Survey Sheet plan XXXIII. 21.6.III. Block C).

**THE TRADING WITH THE ENEMY LAWS, 1939 TO 1945.**

ORDER MADE BY THE GOVERNOR UNDER SECTIONS 3 (2) AND 7 (1).

In exercise of the powers vested in me by sections 3 (2) and 7 (1) of the Trading with the Enemy Laws, 1939 to 1945 (hereinafter referred to as "the Law") I, the Governor, do hereby order as follows:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Trading with the Enemy (Authorization) (Japan) Order, 1947.
