BYE-LAWS MADE BY THE COUNCIL OF THE MUNICIPAL CORPORATION OF LIMASSOL.

These bye-laws may be cited as the Municipal Corporation Gazettes: (Limassol) (Amendment No. 3) Bye-laws, 1947, and shall be read as one 26.6.1931 with the Municipal Corporation (Limassol) Bye-laws, 1931 to 1947 to with the Municipal Corporation (Limassol) Bye-laws, 1931 to 1941 Supplement (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Bye-laws") and the principal No. 3: Bye-laws and these bye-laws may together be cited as the Municipal 17.7.1947, Corporation (Limassol) Bye-laws, 1931 to (No. 3) 1947. 2. Bye-law 26 (1) of the principal Bye-laws is hereby amended by the

deletion of paragraph (b) thereof and the substitution therefor of the

following paragraph:—

"(b) For any other animal, 2p. per oke or part thereof of the careass for the first 60 okes, 1p. for every oke or part thereof of such carcass in excess of the first 60 okes but not exceeding 140 okes, and 20 paras for every oke or part thereof of such carcass in excess of the first 140 okes."

3. These bye-laws shall be deemed to have come into operation on the 9th day of September, 1947.
