THE FORESHORE PROTECTION LAW, 1934.

NOTICE UNDER SECTION 3.

In exercise of the powers vested in me by the Foreshore Protection Law, 1934, I do hereby give notice that :—

- (1) except under a written permit from me and under such conditions as I may think fit to impose thereby, the removal of stones, shingle, gravel, sand or other substance from all that area of foreshore described in the Schedule hereto, is absolutely prohibited;
- (2) the dumping of any rubble, rubbish, sweepings, litter, night-soil or other refuse upon any part of the foreshore described in the Schedule hereto, is absolutely prohibited.

SCHEDULE.

The Foreshore commences at the most northern point of Plot No. 21 of the Government Survey Plan No. XXVI/6, locality “Ayios Elias Church” and proceeds eastwards and south-eastwards along the northern and eastern boundary of the said plot to the south-western corner of Plot No. 24 of the said plan on the right bank of a river; thence south-westwards in a straight line across the said river to the north-western point of Plot No. 61 of the
