THE QUARANTINE LAW, 1932.

QUARANTINE STATIONS.

It is hereby notified for general information that His Excellency the Acting Governor in exercise of the powers conferred by section 5 of the Quarantine Law, 1932, has been pleased to order that the following place in the Colony be provided as a Quarantine Station for the purposes of the said Law or of any regulations made thereunder, that is to say:—

Three houses known as ex-Military Hospital, bounded by several ex-military buildings and situate to the North-West of the village of Zyyi, having the main road leading to Maroni village on the North and private roads belonging to Mr. Eddie Esseyegh on the West, South and East.
