No. 96. THE POST OFFICE LAWS, 1881 TO 1933.
ORDER IN COUNCIL No. 2235
MADE UNDER SECTION 6.

I, the Governor in Council, in exercise of the powers conferred by Section 6 of the Post Office Laws, 1881 to 1933, do hereby order as follows:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Parcels Post (Rates of Postage) (Amendment No. 2) Order, 1947, and shall be read as one with the Parcels Post (Rates of Postage) Orders, 1946 and 1947 (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Order"), and the principal Order and this Order may together be cited as the Parcels Post (Rates of Postage) Orders, 1946 to (No. 2) 1947.

2. The Schedule to the principal Order is hereby amended as follows:—

- (a) by the addition thereto in their alphabetical order of the new entries set out in the First Schedule hereto;
- (b) by the deletion therefrom of the entries relating to the countries shown in the Second Schedule hereto and the substitution therefor of the entries relating to the same countries set out in the Second Schedule hereto.
