In exercise of the powers vested in me by section 3 of the Forest Law, 1939, I, the Governor, with the advice of the Executive Council, do hereby order as follows:—

- 1. This Order may be cited as the Minor State Forests (Limassol) (Amendment) Order, 1948, and shall be read as one with the Minor State Forests (Limassol) Order, 1944 (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Order"), and the principal Order and this Order may together be cited as the Minor State Forests (Limassol) Orders, 1944 and 1948.
- 2. The Schedule to the principal Order is hereby amended by the deletion therefrom of the area No. 1 (relating to the village of Agridhia) and the substitution therefor of the following area:—
  - "1. Agridhia in the District of Limassol:

All that area comprising plots 543, 1017/1/1 and 1017/2 of Government Survey Plan Serial No. XXXVII.56 being approximately 28 donums in extent and shown edged in green on the Government Survey Plan Serial No. 1377."
