THE POST OFFICE LAWS, 1881 TO 1933.

ORDER IN COUNCIL No. 2308 MADE UNDER SECTION 6.

In exercise of the powers vested in the Governor by section 6 of the Post Office Laws, 1881 to 1933, I, the Acting Governor, with the advice of the Executive Council, do hereby order as follows:
