THE TRADING WITH THE ENEMY LAWS, 1939 TO 1945.

ORDER MADE BY THE GOVERNOR UNDER SECTIONS 3 (2) AND 12B.

WINSTER,

Governor.

In exercise of the powers vested in me by sections 3 (2) and 12B of the Trading with the Enemy Laws, 1939 to 1945, (hereinafter referred to as "the Law"), I, the Governor, do hereby order as follows:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Trading with the Enemy (Enemy Territory Cessation) (Albania) Order, 1948.

2. Albania shall for the purposes of sections 5A, 6, 7 and 9 of the Law and for the purposes of any Order made under section 9 cease to be treated as if it were enemy territory.

3. Notwithstanding anything contained in section 3 of the Law, any person, unless I otherwise direct, may trade within Albania with any individual or body of persons (whether corporate or unincorporate) resident or carrying on business therein.

4. This Order shall be deemed to have come into operation on the 31st May, 1948.
