NOTICE UNDER SECTION 11.

Notice is hereby given that with the approval of the Acting Conservator of Forests, the forest set out in the Schedule hereto has been placed for a term of five years as from 15th October, 1948, under the protection, control and management of the Government in accordance with Section 11 of the Forest Law, 1939.

THE PUBLIC HEALTH (VILLAGES) LAWS, 1936 TO 1948.

The following rules made by the Village Health Commission of Athna, in the District of Famagusta, and approved by the Commissioner, are published in the *Gazette*.

RULES MADE BY THE VILLAGE HEALTH COMMISSION OF ATHNA
UNDER SECTION 9.

In exercise of the powers vested in them by section 9 of the Public Health (Villages) Laws, 1936 to 1948, the Village Health Commission of Athna hereby make the following rules:—

1. These rules may be cited as the Village Health (Athna) (Amendment) Rules, 1948, and shall be read as one with the Village Health (Athna) Rules, 1938 (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Rules"), and the principal Rules and these rules may together be cited as the Village Health (Athna) Rules, 1938 and 1948. *Gazette: Suppl. No. 3A: 9.9.1938.*

2. Rules 20 and 46 of the principal Rules are hereby repealed and the following rules substituted therefor, respectively:—

"Rule 20.—The following fees shall be paid to the Inspector by the owner or the person slaughtering any animal in the slaughter-house:—

(a) for every bullock, camel, cow or ox	1	0
(b) for every goat, sheep, kid or lamb above 10 okes carcass weight	—	7
(c) for every goat, sheep, kid or lamb of 10 okes or under carcass weight	—	5
(d) for every swine above 30 okes carcass weight ...	1	6
(e) for every swine of 30 okes or under carcass weight ...	1	1
(f) for every he-goat or ram over one year of age... ..	1	1

Rule 46.—The following fees shall be paid to the Inspector by every person exposing for sale any fresh meat in the meat market, that is to say:—

(a) for every carcass of bullock, camel, cow or ox ...	1	0
(b) for every carcass of goat, sheep, kid or lamb above 10 okes carcass weight	—	5
(c) for every carcass of goat, sheep, kid or lamb of 10 okes or under carcass weight	—	4
(d) for every carcass of swine above 30 okes carcass weight	1	3
(e) for every carcass of swine of 30 okes or under carcass weight	—	8
(f) for every carcass of he-goat or ram over one year of age	—	8
