**THE AGRICULTURAL PRODUCE (EXPORT) LAW, 1933.**

REGULATIONS MADE UNDER SECTION 8.

WINSTER,

*Governor.*

In exercise of the powers vested in me by section 8 of the Agricultural Produce (Export) Law, 1933, I, the Governor, with the advice of the Executive Council, do hereby make the following regulations:—

1. These regulations may be cited as the Agricultural Produce (Citrus Fruit) Export (Amendment) Regulations, 1948, and shall be read as one with the Agricultural Produce (Citrus Fruit) Export Regulations, 1934, and No. 2, 1934 (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Regulations"), and the principal Regulations and these regulations may together be cited as the Agricultural Produce (Citrus Fruit) Export Regulations, 1934 to 1948.

2. Regulation 12 of the principal Regulations is hereby amended by the insertion therein, at the end thereof, of the following proviso (the full stop being replaced by a colon):—

" Provided that boxes of citrus fruit intended for export to the Ministry of Food in the United Kingdom shall be marked in such manner as the Controller of Supplies, Transport and Marketing may direct ".
