THE LAND ACQUISITION LAWS, 1899 TO 1947.

NOTIFICATION UNDER SECTIONS 2, 3 AND 4.

WINSTER,
Governor.

Whereas it has been represented to me that it is desirable in the public interest to establish a Monitoring Station at Karavas, in the District of Kyrenia, and that certain lands are needed in connection therewith;

Now, therefore, I, Reginald Thomas Herbert, Baron Winstler of Witherslack, Privy Counsellor, Knight Commander of the Most Distinguished Order of Saint Michael and Saint George, Governor and Commander-in-Chief in and over the Colony of Cyprus, in exercise of the powers vested in me by sections 2, 3 and 4 of the Land Acquisition Laws, 1899 to 1947, do hereby declare the establishment of a Monitoring Station as aforesaid and the acquisition of lands in connection therewith to be an undertaking of public utility and do hereby authorize the carrying out of the said undertaking and do hereby entrust the supervision and effectuation of the said undertaking to the Commissioner, Kyrenia.
