THE SUPPLIES AND SERVICES (TRANSITIONAL POWERS)  
(CYPRUS) ORDER, 1946.

ORDER MADE BY THE COMPETENT AUTHORITY UNDER DEFENCE  
REGULATION 61.

In exercise of the powers vested in me by virtue of my appointment by the Governor as the Competent Authority for the purposes of Regulation 61 as set out in the First Schedule to the Supplies and Services (Transitional Powers) (Cyprus) Order, 1946, I hereby order as follows:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Defence (Control of Sale Prices of Imported Articles) (Amendment) Order, 1948, and shall be read as one with the Defence (Control of Sale Prices of Imported Articles) Orders, 1943 to (No. 3) 1947 (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Order"), and the principal Order and this Order may together be cited as the Defence (Control of Sale Prices of Imported Articles) Orders, 1943 to 1948.

2. Clause 2 of the principal Order is hereby amended by the deletion therefrom of the definition of "Imported Article" and the substitution therefor of the following definition:—

" 'Imported Article' means any article of the kinds specified in column 2 of the Second Schedule hereto imported into the Colony from any place outside the Colony."

3. Clauses 5, 6 and 7 of the principal Order are hereby amended by the deletion therefrom of the words "imported article" wherever they occur and the substitution therefor of the words "article imported into the Colony from outside the Colony".

4. The Second Schedule to the principal Order is hereby deleted and the following Schedule substituted therefor:—
