

No. 438. THE BURIALS LAWS, 1896 AND 1937.**ORDER UNDER SECTION 1.**

In exercise of the powers vested in the Governor by section 1 of the Burials Laws, 1896 and 1937, and delegated to me by Notification No. 172 published in Supplement No. 3 to the *Gazette* of the 19th June, 1947, I, Craig Reid Cantlie Donald, Commissioner of the District of Famagusta, do hereby order that a new burial ground shall be provided, under the provisions of the said Laws, for use by the Greek, Orthodox community of the village of Mandres in Famagusta District, in lieu of the burial ground now in use by the said community.

No. 439. THE LAND ACQUISITION LAWS, 1899 TO 1947.**NOTICE UNDER SECTION 5.**

With reference to the Notification published under No. 313 in Supplement No. 3 to *Gazette* No. 3389 of 26th August, 1948, notice is hereby given that the following lands are required by the Governor for an undertaking of public utility, that is to say, the establishment of a Military Administrative Area:

All that area of private property situated at Dherinia and Phreñaros Villages in the District of Famagusta at the localities "Kourkounia", "Ayios Nikolaos" and "Barecki", bounded on three sides by private and Crown property and on one side by the main road from Larnaca to Famagusta, comprising 275½ donums or thereabouts and including part of plots Nos. 255, 302, 303, 305, 299, 308, 309, 298, 321, 324 and 340, and whole plots Nos. 342.3, 306, 307, 310, 311, 312, 254, 253, 250, 249, 247, 313, 314, 315, 246, 316, 317, 318, 319, 320, 336, 335, 334, 330, 331, 332, 333, 339, 338, 337, 224, 235, 236 and 237 of the Government Survey Plan No. XXXIII.26E, more particularly defined as the area coloured red on the plan marked "Military Administrative Area", dated 10th November, 1948, deposited with the Commissioner, Famagusta.

2. Any person claiming to have any right or interest in the said lands is required within six weeks from the date of this notice to send to me a statement of his right and interest and of the evidence thereof, and of any claim made by him in respect of such right or interest.

3. The Governor is willing to treat for the acquisition of the said lands.

4. A plan showing the lands described above is available for inspection at my office in Famagusta.
