ORDER IN COUNCIL No. 2328
MADE UNDER SECTION 6.

In exercise of the powers vested in the Governor by section 6 of the Customs Laws, 1936 to (No. 3) 1948, I, the Acting Governor, with the advice of the Executive Council, do hereby order as follows:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Customs Houses (Days and Hours of Business) Order, 1948.

2. Subject to clause 3 of this Order all Customs Houses shall be open for the transaction of business on every day in the week as follows:—

(a) in the months of June to October, both months inclusive, in every year—

(i) from 8 a.m. to noon and from 3 p.m. to 6 p.m. on Mondays, Tuesdays, Thursdays and Fridays;

(ii) from 8 a.m. to noon and from 3 p.m. to 5 p.m. on Wednesdays;

(iii) from 8 a.m. to noon on Saturdays;

(b) in the months of November in every year to May of the following year, both months inclusive—

(i) from 8 a.m. to noon and from 2 p.m. to 5 p.m. on Mondays, Tuesdays, Wednesdays, Thursdays and Fridays;

(ii) from 8 a.m. to noon on Saturdays.

3. All Customs Houses shall be closed for business on Sundays, Saturdays after noon, New Year's Day, Good Friday (Greek-Orthodox), Saturday before Easter (Greek-Orthodox), Easter Monday (Greek-Orthodox), Empire Day, His Majesty's Birthday, Christmas Day and Boxing Day.

4. Notwithstanding anything in this Order contained a Collector may give special permission for overtime work to be carried out by Customs Officers in the District in which he is appointed on any day at such rates as may be prescribed from time to time by the Comptroller for the services of such officers.

5. The Customs Houses (Days and Hours of Business) Orders, 1943 to 1947, are hereby revoked.
