No. 447.**THE DEFENCE (CONTROL OF SALE PRICES OF SCHEDULED ARTICLES) CONSOLIDATION ORDERS, 1940 TO 1942.****NOTICE NO. 235 UNDER CLAUSE 13.**

The Schedule is hereby amended by the deletion therefrom of Part 23 and the substitution therefor of the following Part:—

“PART 23.—KEROSENE.

Seller	Price per gallon
A. By an oil company	12 piastres.
B. By a retailer carrying on business within 3 miles of an oil company	12½ piastres.
C. By a retailer carrying on business at a distance greater than 3 miles of an oil company .. .	14 piastres.

Provided that up to 31st December, 1948, but not afterwards, in all cases of sale of kerosene contained in new sealed tins of four gallons each and sold in the same condition as imported by the Oil Companies, the price shall remain as provided in Notification No. 234 under clause 13 of the Order published in Supplement No. 3 of the *Cyprus Gazette* No. 3401 on the 4th November, 1948.”
