SUBSIDIARY LEGISLATION.

No. 338. THE BURIALS LAWS, 1896 AND 1937.

ORDER MADE UNDER SECTION 14.

Whereas in pursuance of Notification No. 237, published in Supplement No. 3 of the *Gazette* of the 23rd August, 1945, a fit and proper site has been registered in the books of the Land Registry Office as a burial ground for the burial of the dead by the Moslem Community of the village of Evdhimou, in the District of Limassol:

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers vested in the Governor by section 14 of the Burials Laws, 1896 and 1937, and duly delegated to me under Notification No. 172, published in Supplement No. 3 to the *Gazette* of the 19th June, 1947, I do hereby order that no burial shall take place in the burial ground in lieu whereof the new burial ground above referred to has been provided.
