ORDER IN COUNCIL No. 2393

MADE UNDER SECTION 6.

In exercise of the powers vested in me by section 6 of the Post Office Laws, 1881 to 1933, I, the Governor, with the advice of the Executive Council, do hereby order as follows:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Post Office (Air Mail Rate of Postage) (Amendment) Order, 1950, and shall be read as one with the Post Office (Air Mail Rate of Postage) Order, 1949 (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Order"), and the principal Order and this Order may together be cited as the Post Office (Air Mail Rate of Postage) Orders, 1949 and 1950.

2. The Schedule to the principal Order is hereby amended by the deletion therefrom of the entry relating to the "United Kingdom" and the substitution therefor of the following entry:—

Country of Destination	Route	Letters per ½ oz. or part thereof	Postcards	Second class mail per ½ oz. or part thereof
UNITED KINGDOM ..	Direct	<i>piastres.</i> 5	<i>piastres.</i> 3	<i>piastres.</i> 2½
