

2. Regulation 52 of the principal Regulations is hereby amended by the deletion therefrom of paragraphs (1), (1A) and (2) and the substitution therefor of the following paragraphs:—

“(1) Leave to officers of and above the rank of Assistant Superintendent shall be governed by Cyprus General Orders, ~~and Leave and Passage Regulations~~ as in force from time to time.

(1A) Officers below the rank of Assistant Superintendent and non-commissioned officers and constables may be granted vacation leave at the rate of  $3\frac{1}{2}$  days for each completed month of service. Leave may not be accumulated in respect of more than 36 months' service.

(2) Officers below the rank of Assistant Superintendent and non-commissioned officers and constables may be granted sick leave, half pay leave and leave without pay in accordance with the Cyprus General Orders relating to such leave in respect of ~~officials paid from Personal Emoluments.~~ *“established officers”*.
