**No. 176. THE PHARMACY AND POISONS LAW, 1945.**

**RULES MADE BY THE PHARMACY AND POISONS BOARD UNDER SECTION 10.**

In exercise of the powers vested in them by section 10 of the Pharmacy and Poisons Law, 1945, the Pharmacy and Poisons Board with the approval of the Governor in Council hereby make the following rules:—

1. These Rules may be cited as the Pharmacy (Examinations) (Amendment) Rules, 1950, and shall be read as one with the Pharmacy (Examinations) Rules, 1947 (hereinafter referred to as "the Principal Rules") and the Principal Rules and these Rules may together be cited as the Pharmacy (Examinations) Rules, 1947 and 1950.

2. Paragraph (a) of Rule 7 of the Principal Rules is hereby deleted and the following paragraph substituted therefor:—

“(a) either a certificate that he has passed the “Teachers’ Training College” entrance Examination, or a certificate for a full passing out of any one of the following institutions, that is to say—

the English School, Nicosia,  
 the American Academy, Larnaca,  
 the Moslem Lycée,  
 the Pancyprian Gymnasium, Nicosia,  
 the Gymnasium, Limassol,  
 the Gymnasium, Famagusta,  
 the Gymnasium, Paphos,  
 the Gymnasium, Kyrenia,  
 the Commercial Lyceum, Larnaca,  
 the American Academy for girls, Nicosia,

**No. 177. THE FOREST LAWS, 1939 AND 1948.**

**LICENCE UNDER SECTION 6.**

In exercise of the powers vested in me under section 6 of the Forest Laws, 1939 and 1948, I, R. R. Waterer, Conservator of Forests, do hereby give licence to the inhabitants for the time being of the village of Yerani in the District of Famagusta to—

- (a) gather dead and dry fuel other than burned fuel; and
- (b) cut any part of the schinia bush growing above ground, in the Kantara Main State Forest.
