SUBSIDIARY LEGISLATION.

No. 21. THE PENSIONS LAW, 1949.

SECTION 2 (1) (PUBLIC SERVICE).

It is hereby notified that the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers vested in him under section 2 (1) of the Pensions Law, 1949, has determined that the following services shall, as from the dates hereinafter appearing, be "public service" for the purposes of the said Law and the Regulations made thereunder:

- (a) Service with the Commonwealth Agricultural Bureau. (30th January, 1948.)
- (b) Service which is pensionable under the Local Government Superannuation Act or a Local Act Scheme. (20th September, 1949.)
- (c) Service which is pensionable under the Local Government Superannuation (Scotland) Act, 1937, or a Local Act Scheme. (20th December, 1949.)

2. Notification No. 374 in Supplement No. 3 to the *Cyprus Gazette* of the 4th December, 1947, is hereby cancelled.

No. 22. THE ELEMENTARY EDUCATION LAWS, 1933 TO 1949.

ORDER MADE UNDER SECTION 52.

In exercise of the powers conferred by section 52 of the Elementary Education Laws, 1933 to 1949, and on the report of the Director of Education, I, the Governor, do hereby order that the Village Commissions for the Greek-Orthodox Schools of the villages mentioned in the first column of the Schedule hereto shall in their respective villages provide, erect, repair, extend, improve or develop the school buildings, premises, playgrounds, yards, gardens or teachers' dwellings, as the case may be, particulars whereof are given in the second column of the said Schedule.
