THE PUBLIC HEALTH (VILLAGES) LAWS, 1936 TO 1948.

In exercise of the powers vested in me by section 2 of the Public Health (Villages) Laws, 1936 to 1948, I, the Governor, with the advice of the Executive Council, do hereby order that the villages of Elea and Vizakia, in the District of Nicosia, and Marona, in the District of Paphos, shall be added to the Schedule to the said Laws, in their proper alphabetical order under the headings "Nicosia District" and "Paphos District" respectively.

THE ELEMENTARY EDUCATION LAWS, 1933 TO 1949.

ORDER MADE UNDER SECTION 52.

In exercise of the powers conferred by section 52 of the Elementary Education Laws, 1933 to 1949, and on the report of the Director of Education, I, the Governor, do hereby order that the Town Committees or Village Commissions for the Moslem Schools of the towns and the villages mentioned in the first column of the Schedule hereto shall in their respective towns or villages provide, erect, repair, extend, improve or develop the school buildings, premises, playgrounds, yards, gardens or teachers' dwellings, as the case may be, particulars whereof are given in the second column of the said Schedule.
