THE PUBLIC HEALTH (VILLAGES) LAWS, 1936 TO 1948.

ORDER IN COUNCIL No. 2418

MADE UNDER SECTION 9A.

*Authority to the Village Health Commission of Pendayia (Nicosia District)
to contract a loan.*

In exercise of the powers vested in me by section 9A of the Public Health (Villages) Laws, 1936 to 1948, I, the Governor, with the advice of the Executive Council, do hereby order as follows:—

1. The Village Health Commission of Pendayia (Nicosia District) (hereinafter referred to as "the Commission") is hereby authorized to borrow from the Loan Commissioners (hereinafter referred to as "the Lender") the sum of two hundred and fifty pounds (£250) at a rate of interest not exceeding four per centum (4%) per annum, subject to the following terms and conditions, that is to say:—

- (a) that the sum borrowed shall be repayable by the Commission to the Lender in six equal annual instalments (comprising sinking fund and interest);
- (b) that the sum borrowed shall be utilized by the Commission for reconditioning the village streets.

2. That for the purposes of securing the repayment of the sums due under the loan the Commission is hereby authorized, subject to any prior mortgage thereon, to mortgage to the Lender all charges and rates now payable or hereafter to become payable to the Commission under the provisions of the Public Health (Villages) Laws, 1936 to 1948.
