## THE SUMMER RESORTS (DEVELOPMENT) LAWS, 1938 AND 1946.

## NOTIFICATION UNDER SECTION 29.

Whereas the Summer Resort Development Board of Kakopetria in the District of Nicosia has decided by unanimous resolution that the land (house and yard, and field with trees) situated in Kakopetria, particulars whereof are set out in the Schedule hereto, should be acquired for the erection of a public market;

And whereas such land could not be acquired or bought by agreement between the owners thereof and the Board;

And whereas a copy of the resolution and of the minutes relating to it, together with a plan of the land to be acquired, was forwarded by the aforementioned Board to the Commissioner of Nicosia ;

And whereas the Commissioner, after causing notices to be served on the owners of the land proposed to be acquired and otherwise complying with the provisions of section 28 of the Summer Resorts (Development) Laws, 1938 and 1946, has forwarded to the Governor the resolution, minutes and plan together with the objections made thereto :

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers vested in me by section 29 of the Summer Resorts (Development) Laws, 1938 and 1946, I, the Governor, do hereby sanction the acquisition of the said land for the purpose aforesaid.

All that land in the village of Kakopetria together with buildings and trees standing thereon, comprising plots 73/1, 73/2 and 79 of the Government Survey Plan XXXVII/21 of the village of Kakopetria ; all which area is more particularly defined as the area coloured red on the plan marked "A" dated 5th August, 1950, and signed by the Chairman, Kakopetria Summer Resort Development Board.
