

whom has been conferred the Decoration of the Military Cross and Bar, Governor and Commander-in-Chief in and over the Colony of Cyprus, by virtue of the powers vested in me by sections 2 and 3 of the Land Acquisition Laws, 1899 to 1947, do hereby declare the construction, within the village area of Strovolos, of a reservoir, in connection with the aforesaid scheme, to be an undertaking of public utility and do hereby authorize the carrying out of the said undertaking under the provisions of the said Laws and do hereby, by virtue of the powers vested in me by section 4 of the said Laws, entrust the supervision of the said undertaking to the Water Engineer.

And further that the period set out in the Schedule to the aforementioned Laws (in connection with claims by persons claiming any rights or interests) shall be abridged from six weeks to ten days.

The Notification published under No. 362 in Supplement No. 3 to the *Gazette* of 29th September, 1949, is hereby cancelled.

THE QUARANTINE LAW, 1932.

NOTIFICATION UNDER SECTION 4.

In exercise of the powers vested in him by section 4 of the Quarantine Law, 1932, or otherwise, His Excellency the Governor is pleased to declare and hereby declares that the local areas in the first column of the Schedule hereto are infected local areas and that all passengers and goods therefrom shall, as from the date hereof, be subject to the measures prescribed by the Quarantine Regulations, 1932 to (No. 2) 1948, with respect to the dangerous infectious diseases in the second column of the said Schedule.

The Notification No. 237, published in Supplement No. 3 to the *Gazette* of the 29th June, 1950, is hereby cancelled.
