THE CORPORATE BODIES (IMMOVABLE PROPERTY REGISTRATION) LAWS, 1908 TO 1948.

DECLARATION UNDER SECTION 2 (f).

A. B. Wright, Governor.

In exercise of the powers vested in me by paragraph (f) of section 2 of the Corporate Bodies (Immovable Property Registration) Laws, 1908 to 1948, I, the Governor, hereby declare the Government of the United States of America to be a corporate body for the purpose of acquiring and having registered in its name, under the provisions and for the purposes of the said Laws, the following properties:—

(a) Plot Nos. 494/2, 495/2, 472/2, 471/2, 473/2, 458, 460 and 461 of the Government Survey Plan No. XXI/35.

(b) Plot No. 249 of Block D. of Beuyuk Kaimakli.

No. 370. THE LAND ACQUISITION LAWS, 1899 TO 1947.

NOTIFICATION UNDER SECTION 2.

Whereas it has been represented to me that it is desirable in the public interest that the Municipal Corporation of Kyrenia should acquire certain land situated at the locality Boghazi in the village of Bellapais on which a borehole from which Kyrenia Town obtains its water supply is found, together with a strip of land over which the masonry channel conducting the water runs;

Now, therefore, I, the Governor, in exercise of the powers vested in me by section 2 of the Land Acquisition Laws, 1899 to 1947, do hereby declare that the Council of the Municipal Corporation of Kyrenia shall be recognized as a public body for the purposes of the said Laws.
