THE PUBLIC HEALTH (VILLAGES) LAWS, 1936 TO 1948.

ORDER IN COUNCIL No. 2450

MADE UNDER SECTION 9A.

Authority to the Village Health Commission of Prastio, Famagusta District, to contract a loan.

In exercise of the powers vested in me by section 9A of the Public Health (Villages) Laws, 1936 to 1948, I, the Governor, with the advice of the Executive Council, do hereby order as follows:—

1. The Village Health Commission of Prastio, Famagusta District, (hereinafter referred to as "the Commission") shall be at liberty to borrow from the Loan Commissioners (hereinafter referred to as "the Lender") the sum of one thousand nine hundred pounds (£1,900) at a rate of interest not exceeding four per centum (4%) per annum, subject to the following terms and conditions, that is to say:—

- (a) the sum borrowed shall be repayable by the Commission to the Lender in ten equal annual instalments (comprising sinking fund and interest);
