No. 531. THE IRRIGATION (PRIVATE WATER) ASSOCIATION LAW, 1949.

In pursuance of the provisions of sub-section (3) of section 12 of the Irrigation (Private Water) Association Law, 1949, the following Rules made by the Committee of the Irrigation Association of Vasilia (“Uvalla” Water), in the District of Kyrenia, are published in the *Gazette*.

IRRIGATION ASSOCIATION OF VASILIA (“UVALLA” WATER).

Rules.

- These Rules may be cited as the Irrigation Association of Vasilia (“Uvalla” Water) Rules, 1950.
- In these Rules, unless the context otherwise requires—
 - “Commissioner” means the Commissioner of the District of Kyrenia;
 - “Committee” means the Committee of the Irrigation Association;
 - “Irrigation Association” means the Irrigation Association of Vasilia (“Uvalla” Water);
 - “Law” means the Irrigation (Private Water) Association Law, 1949;
 - “List” means the list of the names and residences of the proprietors and of the extent of the interest of each proprietor in the water, as finally settled in accordance with the provisions of section 11 of the Law;
 - “works” means the irrigation works of the Irrigation Association;
 - “water” means the water commonly known as “Uvalla” Water.
- The present Committee shall hold office for a period of three years beginning on the 26th November, 1950. The election of each subsequent Committee shall take place in the manner hereinafter provided every third year in the third week of the month of November and it shall hold office for a period of three years from the date of the expiration of the period of office of the previous Committee.
- (1) The Commissioner shall, not less than one month before the holding of the meeting as in rule 3 provided, cause a written notice thereof to be—
 - published in a newspaper or newspapers; and
 - posted in a conspicuous place in the town, village or quarter in which the water is situate.
