THE MUNICIPAL CORPORATIONS LAWS, 1930 TO 1950.

BYE-LAWS MADE BY THE MUNICIPAL COMMISSION OF THE MUNICIPAL CORPORATION OF LIMASSOL.

In exercise of the powers vested in them by the Municipal Corporations Laws, 1930 to 1950, and otherwise, the Municipal Commission of the Municipal Corporation of Limassol hereby make the following bye-laws :—

1. These bye-laws may be cited as the Municipal Corporation (Limassol) (Amendment) Bye-laws, 1951, and shall be read as one with the Municipal Corporation (Limassol) Bye-laws, 1931 to 1950 (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Bye-laws"), and the principal Bye-laws and these bye-laws may together be cited as the Municipal Corporation (Limassol) Bye-laws, 1931 to 1951.

2. The Second Schedule to the principal Bye-laws is hereby deleted and the following Schedule substituted therefor :—

(v) On each ticket the total price of which exceeds 2s. but does not exceed 3s.	6
(vi) On each ticket the total price of which exceeds 3s. but does not exceed 10s.: on each shilling or part thereof of such price	2
(vii) On each ticket the total price of which exceeds 10s.: on each shilling or part thereof of such price	3"
