**THE SUPPLIES AND SERVICES (TRANSITIONAL POWERS)
(CYPRUS) ORDER, 1946.**

ORDER BY THE GOVERNOR UNDER DEFENCE REGULATION 55.

In exercise of the powers vested in me under Defence Regulation 55 as set out in the First Schedule to the Supplies and Services (Transitional Powers) (Cyprus) Order, 1946, which continues in force in consequence of the Supplies and Services (Continuance) Order, 1950, I, the Governor, do hereby make the following Order:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Supplies and Services (Motor Transport) (Operational Licensing) Amendment Order, 1951, and shall be read as one with the Supplies and Services (Motor Transport) (Operational Licensing) Order, 1951 (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Order"), and the principal Order and this Order may together be cited as the Supplies and Services (Motor Transport) (Operational Licensing) Orders, 1951.

2. Clause 13 of the principal Order is hereby amended by the addition thereto, at the end thereof, of the following paragraph (the full stop at the end thereof being replaced by a semicolon):—

"(c) in respect of a motor vehicle, the sale, transfer or disposal of which was permitted under any regulation or order in force for the time being, on condition that it will not be used on the road or that it will be broken up or dismantled."

3. This Order shall come into operation on the 1st day of May, 1951.

**THE WATER (DOMESTIC PURPOSES) VILLAGE SUPPLIES
