THE PUBLIC HEALTH (VILLAGES) LAW.

CAP. 142.

The following rules made by the Village Health Commission of Peristerona-Piyi, in the District of Famagusta, and approved by the Commissioner, are published in the *Gazette*.

RULES MADE BY THE VILLAGE HEALTH COMMISSION OF PERISTERONA-PIYI UNDER SECTION 9.

In exercise of the powers vested in them by section 9 of the Public Health (Villages) Law, the Village Health Commission of Peristerona-Piyi hereby make the following rules :—

1. These rules may be cited as the Village Health (Peristerona-Piyi) (Amendment) Rules, 1951, and shall be read as one with the Village Health (Peristerona-Piyi) Rules, 1938 (hereinafter referred to as “the principal Rules”), and the principal Rules and these rules may together be cited as the Village Health (Peristerona-Piyi) Rules, 1938 and 1951. *Gazette: 14.10.1938*

2. The principal Rules are hereby amended by the addition of the following Rule after Rule 57 :—

“Rule 57A. The following fees shall be paid by every person exposing for sale any animal in the fair market during the fair of Ayios Anastasios on the 15th, 16th and 17th of September in each year, that is to say :—

(a) For every bullock, cow, ox, heifer, camel, mule or horse	2	0
(b) For every donkey	1	0
(c) For every goat, ewe, lamb, kid	—	7
(d) For every pig over 6 months of age	—	7
(e) For every pig under 6 months of age	—	7”
