**No. 504. THE PUBLIC HEALTH (VILLAGES) LAW.**

CAP. 142.

The following rules made by the Village Health Commission of Patriki, in the District of Famagusta, and approved by the Commissioner, are published in the *Gazette*.

**RULES MADE BY THE VILLAGE HEALTH COMMISSION OF  
PATRIKI UNDER SECTION 9.**

In exercise of the powers vested in them by section 9 of the Public Health (Villages) Law, the Village Health Commission of Patriki hereby make the following rules:—

1. These rules may be cited as the Village Health (Patriki) (Amendment) Rules, 1951, and shall be read as one with the Village Health (Patriki) Rules, 1938 (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Rules"), and the principal Rules and these rules may together be cited as the Village Health (Patriki) Rules, 1938 to 1951.
