COMPULSORY ACQUISITION ORDER.

THE ANTIQUITIES LAW, CAP. 43,

AND

THE LAND ACQUISITION LAW, CAP. 233.

Whereas His Excellency the Acting Governor is satisfied that in order to preserve the amenities of Pyla Tower, an ancient monument transferred to the First Schedule to the Antiquities Law as item 11 of Larnaca District therein, by Order in Council No. 2465 dated 22nd February, 1951, and published under Notification No. 97 in Supplement No. 3 to the *Cyprus Gazette* of the 28th February, 1951, it is desirable that no building should be erected in the proximity of such ancient monument upon the plot of land described in the Schedule hereto and that any buildings thereon should be demolished;

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers vested in him by section 12 of the Antiquities Law, His Excellency the Acting Governor is pleased to direct and hereby directs that the property described in the Schedule hereto be acquired on payment of such amount by way of compensation as may be agreed upon between the Commissioner of Larnaca and the proprietor thereof and that in default of agreement within one month from the date hereof the amount of compensation be determined in the like manner and in accordance with the provisions of the Land Acquisition Law.
