THE SHEEP AND GOATS (SHEPHERDS' LICENSING AND CONTROL) LAW.

CAP. 157.

NOTICE UNDER SECTION 12.

In exercise of the powers vested in me by section 12 of the Sheep and Goats (Shepherds' Licensing and Control) Law, I hereby direct that during the period between the 21st November, 1951, and the 31st December, 1951, flocks within the area of Paralimni village in the District of Famagusta shall, between the hours of sunset and sunrise, be kept inside an enclosure and not taken outside an enclosure:

Provided that nothing in this notice contained shall prevent the driving of any flock, under the proper charge of a licensed shepherd, from one village area to another, along any public road, at any hour.

THE IRRIGATION CHARGES REGULATIONS, 1931 TO 1951.

NOTIFICATION UNDER REGULATION 2.

In exercise of the powers vested in me by regulation 2 of the Irrigation Charges Regulations, 1931 to 1951, I do hereby prescribe that the charges set out in the second column of the Schedule hereto shall be levied on and paid by any person making use of water from the water-works known as the Eastern Messaoria Irrigation Works, for the kind of crop specified in the first column of such Schedule.

2. The Notification published under No. 25 in Supplement No. 3 to the *Gazette* of the 11th February, 1938, is hereby cancelled.

SCHEDULE.

<i>Kind of crop.</i>		<i>Charges.</i>
Wheat, barley or oats	3s. 4½p.	per donum for every watering.
Flax and other crops irrigated during spring	4s.	do.
Sesame, broom or other crops, except cotton, irrigated during summer	4s.	do.
Cotton	2s. 4½p.	do.
