**THE EMERGENCY LAWS (MISCELLANEOUS PROVISIONS)  
(COLONIES, ETC.) ORDER IN COUNCIL, 1951.**

ORDER MADE BY THE GOVERNOR.

In exercise of the powers vested in me by the Emergency Laws (Miscellaneous Provisions) (Colonies, etc.) Order in Council, 1951, and of every other power thereunto enabling, I, the Governor, do hereby make the following Order:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Emergency Laws (Miscellaneous Provisions) (Cyprus) Order, 1951.

2. The Defence Regulations set out in the Schedule to the Emergency Laws (Transitional Provisions) (Cyprus) Order, 1946, shall continue in force until the 10th day of December, 1952, and the said Order shall have effect as if, for the reference to the 10th day of December, 1951, in clause 3 thereof (as inserted by the Emergency Laws (Miscellaneous Provisions) (Cyprus) Order, 1950), there were substituted a reference to the 10th day of December, 1952.
