THE ORPHANAGE AND TRAINING SCHOOL (DEMETRAKIS
G. DIANELLOS OF LARNACA) LAW, 1950.

REGULATIONS MADE UNDER SECTION 7 (2) (b).

1. These regulations may be cited as the Orphanage and Training School (Demetrakis G. Dianellos of Larnaca) (Board of Management) Regulations, 1952.

2. In these regulations, unless the context otherwise requires, the following expressions shall have the following meanings:—

“board” means the board of management of the Orphanage and Training School, Demetrakis G. Dianellos of Larnaca;

“Law” means the Orphanage and Training School (Demetrakis G. Dianellos of Larnaca) Law, 1950;

“meeting” means the meeting of the board;

“Metropolitan of Kitium” includes the Locum Tenens (Topotritis) of the See of Kitium in case of a vacancy in the office of the Bishop of Kitium;

“secretary” means the secretary of the board.

3. The board shall hold meetings at least once every month.

4. The Metropolitan of Kitium or the secretary shall convene the meetings of the board referred to in regulation 3 of these regulations.

5.—(1) Notwithstanding anything in these regulations contained the Metropolitan of Kitium shall convene a meeting upon the written requisition of at least two members of the board.

Such requisition shall state the object of the meeting and shall be signed by the requisitionists.

(2) If the Metropolitan of Kitium or the secretary does not proceed to convene a meeting within five days from the date of any requisition to that effect, the requisitionists may themselves convene a meeting but any meeting so convened shall be held not later than ten days from the date of the requisition.

(3) Every meeting of the board convened by requisitionists shall be convened in the same manner or as nearly as possible the same as that in which the Metropolitan of Kitium or the secretary shall convene meetings.

6. Forty-eight hours' notice, at least, of the holding of any meeting of the board shall be given to all the members by the person or persons convening such meeting; such notice shall specify the agenda, the place, the day and the hour of such meeting and shall be served on each member personally, or through the post, or by leaving it at his usual place of abode.

7. Three members present in person shall form a quorum.

8. The Metropolitan of Kitium shall preside as chairman at every meeting and if absent the Cypriot Greek Judge shall do so. If the Cypriot Greek Judge is also absent the members present may elect one of their number to act as chairman.

9. The chairman may, with the consent of any meeting at which a quorum is present (and shall if so directed by the meeting) adjourn the meeting from time to time and from place to place but no business shall be transacted at any adjourned meeting other than the business left unfinished at the meeting from which the adjournment took place.

10. If the chairman fails or declines to carry out his duties as such the meeting may elect one of their number to act as chairman for the purpose of continuing the proceedings.

11. The meetings of the board shall be private.

12. Decisions shall be taken by majority of votes. In case of equality of votes, the chairman shall have in addition to his own vote, a second or casting vote.

13. Decisions shall be taken by open vote; if however any two members will request that a decision on any question at any meeting be taken by secret vote it shall be so taken.

14. No act or proceeding of the board shall be deemed to be valid unless a quorum is present in person at the meeting.

15. No business shall be transacted at a meeting other than that specified in the notice given to the members of the board.

16. The members shall at the first meeting in each year elect from among their number by open vote a secretary of the board who shall hold office for one year from his election.

17. Minutes of the proceedings at every meeting shall be entered by the secretary in a book kept for that purpose and shall be signed by all the members present. If the secretary is absent a member of the board shall be chosen to carry out the duties of secretary.

No. 133. THE PUBLIC HEALTH (VILLAGES) LAW.
CAP. 142.

The following rules made by the Village Health Commission of Ayia Phylaxis, in the District of Limassol, and approved by the Commissioner, are published in the *Gazette*.

**RULES MADE BY THE VILLAGE HEALTH COMMISSION OF
AYIA PHYLAXIS UNDER SECTION 9.**

In exercise of the powers vested in them by section 9 of the Public Health (Villages) Law, the Village Health Commission of Ayia Phylaxis hereby make the following rules:—

1. These rules may be cited as the Village Health (Ayia Phylaxis) (Amendment) Rules, 1952, and shall be read as one with the Village Health (Ayia Phylaxis) Rules, 1938 (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Rules"), and the principal Rules and these rules may together be cited as the Village Health (Ayia Phylaxis) Rules, 1938 and 1952.

2. The following Rule shall be substituted for Rule 46 of the principal Rules:—

"Rule 46.—(1) The following fees shall be paid by every person exposing for sale any fresh meat in the meat market, that is to say:—

(a) For every carcass of sheep, goat, kid, lamb, camel, bullock, cow, ox, or part thereof	1 0
(b) For every oke of each carcass of swine	- 0½

(2) The fees in paragraph (1) of this rule described shall not be payable by any person exposing for sale any fresh meat in the meat market, who is a monthly or yearly lessee of any shop, stall or place in the meat market under rule 45 of these rules."

3. The following new Rules shall be inserted immediately at the beginning of "Part IV.—Markets" and before the words "Chapter 2.—Meat Markets" in that Part of the Rules:—

"26. The Village Health Commission may from time to time by public notification appoint any premises or place within the area of the village to be the market of perishable goods.

27. No person shall sell or expose for sale any perishable goods at any place within the area of the village, except at the market of perishable goods appointed by the Village Health Commission.

28. The management and control of the market of perishable goods are hereby vested in the person appointed from time to time by the Village Health Commission to be the Inspector of such market
