## NOTICE UNDER SECTION 12.

In exercise of the powers vested in me by section 12 of the Sheep and Goats (Shepherds' Licensing and Control) Law, I hereby direct that during the period between the 1st June and the 31st July, 1952, flocks within the village area of Pano Arodhes, in the District of Paphos, shall, between the hours of sunset and sunrise, be kept inside an enclosure and not taken outside an enclosure:

Provided that nothing in this notice contained shall prevent the driving of any flock, under the proper charge of a licensed shepherd, from one village area to another, along any public road, at any hour.

## No. 216. THE IRRIGATION DIVISIONS (VILLAGES) LAW.

CAP. 111.

In pursuance of the provisions of section 19 of the Irrigation Divisions (Villages) Law, the following rules made by the Committee of the Irrigation Division of Peristerona-Piyi (Koundouros), in the District of Famagusta, are published in the *Gazette*.

## IRRIGATION DIVISION OF PERISTERONA-PIYI (KOUNDOUROS).

*Rules.*

1. These rules may be cited as the Irrigation Division of Peristerona-Piyi (Koundouros) Rules, 1952.

2. In these rules, unless the context otherwise requires—

“Commissioner” means the Commissioner of the District of Famagusta;

“Committee” means the Committee of the Irrigation Division;

“Irrigation Division” means the Irrigation Division of Peristerona-Piyi (Koundouros);

“Law” means the Irrigation Divisions (Villages) Law, Cap. 111;

“list” means the list of the names and residence of the proprietors and of the lands and extent thereof which are to be benefited or are capable of being benefited by the works prepared under the provisions of section 15 of the Law as finally settled under the provisions of section 16 of the Law;

“works” means the irrigation works of the Irrigation Division.

3. The Committee shall hold office for a period of three years beginning on the 26th February, 1952. Thereafter the election of the Committee shall take place every third year in the first week of the month of February and it shall hold office for a period of three years from the day next following its election.

4.—(1) The Committee shall appoint a treasurer who shall collect the rates and charges assessed upon the proprietors mentioned in the list.

(2) The treasurer shall, on the 1st November, in every year, prepare a statement of all rates or charges still due and unpaid on that date and shall forward such statement to the Commissioner.
