No. 318. THE PUBLIC RIVERS PROTECTION LAW.

CAP. 143.

ORDER IN COUNCIL No. 2552

MADE UNDER SECTION 3.

In exercise of the powers vested in me under section 3 of the Public Rivers Protection Law, I, the Governor, with the advice of the Executive Council, do hereby order as follows:— Cap. 143.

1. This Order may be cited as the Yialias River (Protection) Order, 1952.
2. The portion of the Public River Yialias, in the villages of Nisou and Perakhorio in the District of Nicosia, 500 yards upstream and 500 yards downstream from the main bridge at Nisou village, more particularly defined as the area coloured red on the Government Survey Plan No. 1553, filed in M.P. (D.I.N.) 64/51 in the office of the Commissioner, Nicosia, is hereby declared to be a river for the purposes of the Public Rivers Protection Law. Cap. 143.

No. 319. THE BAKERIES (NIGHT WORK) LAW, 1950.

ORDER UNDER SECTION 4.

A. B. WRIGHT,

Whereas I am satisfied that in the circumstances prevailing at Amiandos it is desirable that special provision for work at night in the bakery of the Cyprus Asbestos Mines Limited, at Amiandos, should be made:

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers vested in me by section 4 of the Bakeries (Night Work) Law, 1950, I, the Governor, do hereby order

that the restrictions imposed by the said Law shall not apply to the bakery at Amiandos of the Cyprus Asbestos Mines Limited, so long as:—

- (a) persons employed in a nightshift shall not work for more than eight consecutive hours and shall have a break for meal each night;
- (b) a rotation system of one nightshift and two dayshifts shall be worked each extending over one week so as to ensure that no person shall be employed for more than six, or seven if a seven-day week is worked, consecutive nights in every three weeks.

This Order shall expire on the 31st day of December, 1952.

No. 320. THE WATER (DOMESTIC PURPOSES) VILLAGE SUPPLIES LAW.

CAP. 311 AND LAWS 28 OF 1951 AND 12 OF 1952.

In exercise of the powers vested in me by section 3 of the Water (Domestic Purposes) Village Supplies Law, I, the Commissioner of Nicosia and Kyrenia Districts, do hereby declare that the village of Lagoudhera, in the District of Nicosia, shall be a village to which the provisions of the said Law shall apply.

No. 321. THE FORESHORE PROTECTION LAW.

CAP. 92.

NOTICE UNDER SECTION 3 (1).

In exercise of the powers vested in me by section 3 (1) of the Foreshore Protection Law, I hereby absolutely prohibit—

- (a) the removal of stones, shingle, gravel, sand or other substance from all that area of the foreshore described in the Schedule hereto;
- (b) the dumping of any rubble, rubbish, sweepings, litter, night-soil or other refuse upon any part of the foreshore described in the Schedule hereto.

The foreshore commences at the most eastern point of plot No. 361 of the Government Survey Plan No. XII/21, locality "Karakoumitica", and
