In exercise of the powers vested in me by the Emergency Laws (Miscellaneous Provisions) (Colonies, etc.) Order in Council, 1952, and of every other power thereunto enabling, I, the Governor, do hereby make the following Order :—

1. This Order may be cited as the Emergency Laws (Miscellaneous Provisions) (Cyprus) Order, 1952.

The Defence Regulations set out in the Schedule to the Emergency Laws (Transitional Provisions) (Cyprus) Order, 1946, shall continue in force until the 10th day of December, 1953, and the said Order shall have effect as if, for the reference to the 10th day of December, 1952, in clause 3 thereof (as inserted by the Emergency Laws (Miscellaneous Provisions) (Cyprus) Order, 1951), there were substituted a reference to the 10th day of December, 1953.

Whereas the governing bodies of the schools set out in the Schedule hereto secondary schools to which section 24 of the Secondary Education Law (hereinafter referred to as "the Law") is applicable, applied for the declaration of their respective schools to be Public-aided Secondary Schools:

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers vested in me by section 34 (1) of the Law, I, the Governor, do hereby declare each one of the schools set out in the Schedule hereto to be a Public-aided Secondary School.

2. This declaration shall be deemed to have been made on the 1st day of September, 1952.
