ORDER IN COUNCIL No. 2616
MADE UNDER SECTION 7.

In exercise of the powers vested in me by section 7 of the Post Office Law, I, the Governor, with the advice of the Executive Council, do hereby order as follows:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Parcels Post (Rates of Postage) (Amendment) Order, 1953, and shall be read as one with the Parcels Post (Rates of Postage) Orders, 1952 (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Order") and the principal Order and this Order may together be cited as the Parcels Post (Rates of Postage) Orders, 1952 and 1953. *Gazette: Suppl. No. 3: 9.7.1952*

2. The Schedule to the principal Order is hereby amended by the deletion therefrom of the entries relating to the countries shown in the Schedule hereto and the substitution therefor of the entries relating to the same countries set out in the Schedule hereto.
