THE CUSTOMS LAW.

CAP. 292 AND LAWS 5 OF 1952 AND 19 OF 1953 AND 27 OF 1953.

ORDER IN COUNCIL No. 2644

MADE UNDER SECTIONS 52 (a) AND 64 (b).

In exercise of the powers vested in me by sections 52 (a) and 64 (b) of the Customs Law, I, the Governor, with the advice of the Executive Council, do hereby order as follows :—

Cap. 292, 5 of 1952, 19 of 1953, 27 of 1953.

1. This Order may be cited as the Customs (Earthquake Relief Parcels) (Exemption) Order, 1953.

2. Goods, addressed to Government or to an appropriate officer thereof, or to any earthquake relief committee approved by the Colonial Secretary, which the importer declares and the Comptroller is satisfied are imported for earthquake relief purposes, shall be admitted into the Colony free of import duty and wharfage dues.

3. This Order shall be deemed to have come into force on the 19th September, 1953.
