

THE FIREARMS LAW.**(CAP. 86.)****DANGEROUS AIR-GUNS, AIR-RIFLES OR AIR-PISTOLS
(DECLARATION) ORDER.**

1. This Order may be cited as the Dangerous Air-guns, Air-rifles or Air-pistols (Declaration) Order.

2. All air-guns, air-rifles or air-pistols of a calibre exceeding .177 are hereby declared to be dangerous within the meaning of section 3 (1) (b) of the Firearms Law.

THE FIREARMS LAW.**(CAP. 86.)****FIREARMS' REGULATIONS.**

33 Gaz. 750

1. These regulations may be cited as the Firearms Regulations.

2. No person shall carry or use a muzzle-loading gun in a State Forest.

3. Any person who carries or uses a firearm in contravention of these regulations shall be guilty of an offence and shall be liable to imprisonment not exceeding three months or to a fine not exceeding ten pounds or to both and the firearm in respect of which the offence has been committed shall be forfeited.
