NOTICE UNDER THE FIRST SCHEDULE.

It is hereby notified that His Excellency the Governor has approved the following fees and charges for certain services specified in the Table of Fees and Charges to be levied and taken in the Land Registration and Survey Department, as from the 1st day of March, 1954, and until further notice, in matters relating to immovable property, set out in the First Schedule to the Land Registration and Survey Department (Fees and Charges) Law, 1954 :—

1. For survey work done at a local enquiry (item 1 (iii) of the Table of Fees and Charges in the Schedule (hereinafter referred to as "the Table"))—

- (a) for information as to the boundaries of the properties (item 8 (a) (ii) of the Table)—

- (b) for any other information not specified in paragraph 8 of the Table (item 8 (i) of the Table)—  
per hour taken by a clerk to supply the information . . . . . 6s.

3. Evidence (item 13 of the Table)—

- per hour spent on preparing for and giving evidence—
- by a clerk or a surveyor . . . . . 6s.
- by a draughtsman or computer . . . . . 5s. 4p.
- by a chainman . . . . . 4s.

4. For a service not otherwise specified in the Table (item 14 of the Table)—

- per hour spent on performing the service—
- by a clerk or a surveyor . . . . . 6s.
- by a draughtsman or computer . . . . . 5s. 4p.
- by a chainman . . . . . 4s.
- by a labourer—at the appropriate Government wage rate.
