No. 240. THE CUSTOMS LAW.

CAP. 292 AND LAWS 5 OF 1952, 19 OF 1953 AND 27 OF 1953.

ORDER IN COUNCIL No. 2675

MADE UNDER SECTION 4 (a).

In exercise of the powers vested in him under paragraph (a) of section 4 of the Customs Law, His Excellency the Governor, with the advice of the Executive Council, has been pleased to order as follows:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Ports (Amendment) Order, 1954, and shall be read as one with the Ports Order, 1949 (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Order") and the principal Order and this Order may together be cited as the Ports Orders, 1949 and 1954.

2. The Schedule to the principal Order is hereby amended by the insertion at the beginning of each item in the second column thereof of the following words (the word "The" now appearing at the beginning of each such item being replaced by the word "the") :—

"Any Customs store, Customs warehouse, wharf or other place provided or approved by Government for the landing or shipping of goods which are subject to Customs control".
