CAP. 73 AND LAW 39 OF 1953.

ORDER MADE UNDER SECTION 18.

Cap. 73
39 of 1953

In exercise of the powers conferred upon the Governor by section 18 of the Dangerous Drugs Law, His Excellency the Governor has been pleased to order as follows :—

1. The persons whose names appear in the first column of the Schedule hereto are hereby authorized to exercise within the district or area specified in the third column of the said Schedule against the name of each such person, all the powers conferred upon persons so authorized by section 18 of the aforesaid Law.

2. The Order dated the 14th day of May, 1949, published under Notification No. 192 in Supplement No. 3 to the *Gazette* of the 19th May, 1949, is hereby cancelled without prejudice to anything done thereunder.
