THE LAND ACQUISITION LAW.

CAP. 233 AND LAW 26 OF 1952.

NOTIFICATION UNDER SECTIONS 2, 3 AND 5.

R. P. ARMITAGE,

Governor.

Whereas it has been represented to me that it is desirable for military purposes to establish a military storage depot in the District of Larnaca, together with such ancillary buildings, erections, structures and other installations as may be necessary to operate and maintain such depot, the cost whereof is to be borne by Her Majesty's Military Authorities, (hereinafter referred to as "the Storage Depot"):

Now, therefore, I, the Governor, in exercise of the powers vested in me by sections 2, 3 and 5 of the Land Acquisition Law, do hereby declare the establishment of the Storage Depot to be an undertaking of public utility and do hereby authorize the carrying out of the said undertaking and do hereby entrust the supervision and effectuation of the said undertaking to Mr. Percy George Crosby Farrell, the Assistant Director of Hirings and Disposals (Fixed Assets), H.Q. Cyprus District, or in his absence to the person acting for the time being as Assistant Director of Hirings and Disposals (Fixed Assets), Headquarters, Cyprus District.
